

Advanced Open Water Diver

The Adventures in Diving program offers both the Adventure Diver and Advanced Open Water Diver certifications.

If you complete any three adventure dives, you can earn your **PADI Adventure Diver certification**. If you complete your Deep Adventure Dive, Underwater Navigation Adventure Dive and 3 Adventure Dives, for a total of five, you can earn your **Advanced Open Water Diver certification**.

Why Advanced Open Water Diver?

After your adventure dives, you'll be more experienced, feel more comfortable in the water and simply enjoy diving more! because you better understand the underwater environment.

What do I need to start?

- PADI Open Water Diver
- Minimum age: 15 (12 for PADI Junior Advanced Open Water Diver)

What will I do?

This certification includes 5 Adventure Dives:

Deep Dive and Navigation Dive (mandatory for advanced certification)

Multilevel Dive, Wreck Dive and Search/Recovery (the dives usually offered by seurchindivers)

Night Dive, Dive Propulsion Vehicle

Peak Performance Buoyancy Underwater Naturalist, Underwater Photographer.

AWARE Fish Identification,

How long will it take?

- Recommended Course Hours: 15, usually over 2 days
- Minimum Open Water Training: five dives over two days

We usually, but not exclusively, run this course at Stoney Cove in Leicestershire, approx 3.5 hours drive away up the M1. We drive up on the first day and complete 3 dives followed by an additional 3 dives the next day. We stay over at the Mill on the Soar, local to the dive centre.

What will I need?

- Adventures in Diving Crew-Pak
- Log Book

Where can I go from here?

PADI Advanced Open Water Divers at least 15 years of age can enrol in PADI Wreck or Deep Diver Specialty courses and others and continue on to the PADI Rescue Diver course.

What will it Cost?

The basic course fee is **£210.00** plus £28 for the manual, if you require kit hire this is offered at a special course price of £50 for the 2 days. You are required to independently pay for your air fills, accommodation, travel and site entry fees.
