

Open Water Diver

Now is the time to dive into the Open Water Diver course, the most popular dive program in the world! This is your ticket to a lifetime of adventure.

As a certified PADI Open Water Diver, the most widely recognised and respected rating in the world, you have the freedom to dive with a buddy independent of a professional.

What do I need to start?

Virtually anyone who is in good health, reasonably fit, and comfortable in the water can earn a PADI Open Water Diver certification. If you are between 12 and 14 or have a child between these ages, there is a PADI Junior Open Water Diver program available.

What will I do?

Throughout the course, you'll learn fundamentals of scuba diving, including dive equipment and techniques. You earn this rating by completing five pool sessions and knowledge development sessions and finally by making four open water (usually confined sea).

How long will it take?

The course is run over 5 sessions; we combine the same evening for the academic and pool sessions. These are on a Monday eve at the Steyning Pool starting at 7pm and ending at 10pm.

What will I need?

- PADI Open Water Crew-Pak (studied and completed review 1 before coming to class)
- PADI Open Water Video or DVD (we loan you this)
- Log Book

Health requirements

You are required to complete a medical statement; if you have any of the conditions listed, you will have to have your doctor sign the form to say you are fit to dive.

You are not permitted to enter the water without medical clearance.

Also you are required to sign a statement of acceptance of risk and also agree to comply with safe diving practices.

What next?

Contact seaurchindivers, confirm course dates and cost and then place your deposit to reserve your place

What does it Cost?

£295 including your manual for the academic and pool sessions

After the academic and pool sessions you may elect to complete your course on holiday abroad or with us abroad.

£180 additional for the 4 open water dives, this includes site entry fees and kit hire.
