What do I need to start?

Be a qualified diver

What will I do?

We will run through the essential basic scuba skills to make sure you remember what's what

How long will it take?

The programme is run over 2-4 sessions.

These are on a Monday eve at the Steyning Pool starting at 8.15pm and ending at 10pm.

We encourage you to attend some theory sessions but you can complete a review quiz at home to remind yourself of the procedures and main safety points.

What will I need?

- PADI scuba review book or PADI open water manual
- Your Log Book

Health requirements

You are required to complete a medical statement; if you have any of the conditions listed, you will have to have your doctor sign the form to say you are fit to dive.

You are not permitted to enter the water without medical clearance.

Also you are required to sign a statement of acceptance of risk and also agree to comply with safe diving practices.
